Thank you for your continued support and participation. We look forward to organizing more such events to benefit our students and community.
















"EVERYTHING BEGINS WITH AN IDEA." - EARL NIGHTINGALE

On 13/05/24, a team of professionals from Corvuss participated in an enlightening professional development session led by Mick Purcell at Edubridge International School in Mumbai. The session's primary focus was on effective teaching strategies, particularly differentiation and reading comprehension, essential components for fostering an inclusive and supportive learning environment.

During the session, Mr. Purcell introduced comprehensive concepts regarding differentiation, drawing on the ideas of renowned educational theorist Carol Ann Tomlinson. He emphasized the importance of tailoring instruction to meet the diverse needs of students, highlighting practical techniques for implementing differentiation in the classroom. This included strategies for modifying content, process, and product based on students' readiness levels, interests, and learning profiles.

The session was highly interactive, encouraging participants to engage in discussions and share their experiences. This collaborative approach enriched the learning experience, making it both resourceful and practical. The participants explored how differentiation could be effectively applied within various international curricula, ensuring that teaching methods are adaptable to different educational contexts.

Towards the end of the workshop, Mr. Purcell provided practical tips for ensuring a positive learning environment for every child. These tips included strategies for building a supportive classroom culture, fostering positive relationships, and creating engaging and inclusive learning experiences. The session concluded with a reaffirmation of the importance of a holistic approach to education, where academic excellence is balanced with emotional well-being.
